I hope your children are excited about the May 11th dance performance! They are practicing their dances in class, and costumes are on the way!

A rehearsal is scheduled on Saturday, May 4th in Eller Hall located in the Noble Family Performing Arts Center at the Midway campus. A finale dance for dance performance will be taught during the rehearsal and students will practice this dance in class the last week of Extend classes. This is a simple dance to bring all dancers together as a finale to the performance. During rehearsal, the dancers will practice on the stage, find their performance dance spot, and become comfortable with the space. Please pack a water bottle and snack. Costumes are not required.

Performance Day Show A- Saturday, May 11, 2024

Schedule:

• 9:00 a.m. Call time (arrival) for all dancers

• 9:50 a.m. Doors open for audience

• 10:00 a.m. Showtime!

Logistics:

- All dancers should have hair, makeup, and accessories ready before arriving.
- All dancers will gather in the black box which will serve as the backstage area.
 Parents are not permitted to enter the black box.
- Staff and Upper School Dance Company will be backstage to assist the dancers.
- Dancers with more than one dance will be provided with a changing area. Please bring both costumes backstage.
- Everyone is encouraged to stay for the entire performance. There is a finale piece this year.

Rules for Performance Space

- Dancers should wear a cover-up over costumes until performance time, so as not to ruin the element of surprise!
- No food or drinks allowed backstage or in the Eller.
- Dancers should stay in their designated areas and stretch while waiting to appear onstage.
- No flash photography!

Checklist for Performance Day

- Costume
- Dance shoes
- Tights, consider packing an extra pair in case of an emergency
- Extra hair supplies for last minute emergencies
- Hairspray/gel
- Bobby pins
- Hairnet for ballet bun (optional)
- Makeup
- Cover up for costume (e.g., button down, robe)
- Change of clothes for after the performance (optional)
- Water in a spill proof sealed container
- Remove all fingernail and toenail polish for the show
- No jewelry unless otherwise approved by your dance instructor
- Always a positive attitude and lots of energy to dance!!!

Tips to Create a Classical Ballet Bun

- Dampen hair with water, conditioner, or shine serum
- Put hair in a ponytail with an elastic band in the center of the head or a bit higher
- Grab hair and twist it, wrapping it around the elastic
- Wrap hair net around bun and secure it with bobby pins
- Apply hairspray or gel on hair to keep it in place and to get rid of wispy, flyaway strands of hair
